Dear Mr Mery,

I am writing with reference to your request for information regarding the National DNA Database (NDNAD), made under section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act, dated and received by the National Policing Improvement Agency (NPIA) on 12<sup>th</sup> February 2009.

You asked for the following information:-

*For each month between January 2006 to February 2009 included:*

- 1/ The total number of DNA profiles held on the NDNAD at the end of each of the date ranges.*
- 2/ The number of subject DNA profiles loaded on the NDNAD contributed by each contributing organisation.*
- 3/ The number of requests for DNA records removal received by each contributing organisation*
- 4/ The number of DNA profile deleted from the NDNAD for samples taken by each contributing organisation following the granting of a request (under the exceptional case procedure ).*
- 5/ The estimated replication rates for each contributing organisation.*
- 6/ The number of crime scene DNA profiles loaded on the NDNAD contributed by each contributing organisation.*
- 7/ The number of crime scene DNA profiles deleted from the NDNAD for samples taken by each contributing organisation.*

*8/ a/ The number of DNA profiles of children aged under 10 deleted from the NDNAD for samples taken by each contributing organisation following the announcement of the Home Secretary speech 'Common sense approaches to*

In response to your request, we are able to provide you with the following information.

The NDNAD is not a criminal records database. It holds very little information about a subject's identity – only their name, date of birth, sex and ethnic appearance. Inclusion on the DNA database does not signify a criminal record, and there is no personal cost or disadvantage by being on it.

In relation to detailing each contributing organisation; the NPIA can neither confirm nor deny that it holds any additional information relevant to this request, as the duty in Section 1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 does not apply. This notice acts as a refusal notice under the provisions of S17 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, by virtue of the listed exemptions:

Section 23(5) Information Supplied by Security Bodies.  
Section 24(2) National Security

However, this should not be taken as conclusive evidence that the information you requested exists or does not exist.

*1/ The total number of DNA profiles held on the NDNAD at the end of each of the date ranges.*

The NDNAD is a dynamic, continually changing database. Because the data on the NDNAD is constantly changing and records are continually being added and removed, it is generally only possible to provide a "snapshot" of its contents at the current moment in time. Because of this, we are unable to run reports retrospectively to obtain figures on the numbers of profiles held on the NDNAD at the end of each of the date ranges. However, I would draw your attention to some of the relevant information which was published in the previous NDNAD annual reports. We are able to provide the current up to date figures on the NDNAD.

### **Total number of profiles held on the NDNAD as at 27/02/09**

The National DNA Database (NDNAD) holds both DNA profiles derived from samples taken from known individuals (referred to as subject sample profiles) and also DNA profiles derived from samples left at crime scenes from unknown individuals (referred to as crime scene sample profiles).

The figures for subject profiles cover all subjects loaded to the NDNAD and therefore cover both subjects who provided a sample voluntarily, for example for elimination purposes within the context of a specific case, and also criminal justice samples which are those taken from individuals following an arrest for a recordable offence.

It is the number of subject *profiles* held on the NDNAD and this does not equate to the actual number of *individuals* on the NDNAD. The number of subject profiles on the NDNAD is higher than the number of individuals because some of the profiles held are replicates. Replicates arise from samples being taken from the same subject on more than one occasion for example where a person gave different names, or different versions of their name, on separate arrests or where a Police Force chooses to resample them to improve the discriminating power or evidential value of the sample.

*2/ The number of subject DNA profiles loaded on the NDNAD contributed by each contributing organisation.*

The table below shows the number of subject profiles loaded to the NDNAD by each contributing organisation for each month January 2006 to February 2009 (up to 27<sup>th</sup> February 2009). It is the number of profiles loaded during this time not necessarily retained; some of these profiles may have subsequently been deleted.

As above, the figures are for all subject profiles loaded to the NDNAD and therefore covers both subjects who provided a sample voluntarily, for example for elimination purposes within the context of a specific case, and also criminal justice samples which are those taken from individuals following an arrest for a recordable offence.

They refer to the numbers of subject *profiles* loaded to the NDNAD and thus do not equate to the actual number of *individuals* loaded to the NDNAD. The number of subject profiles loaded to the NDNAD is higher than the number of individuals because some of the profiles held are replicates. Replicates arise from samples being taken from the same subject on more than one occasion for example where a person gave different names, or different versions of their name, on separate arrests or where a Police Force chooses to resample them to improve the discriminating power or evidential value of the sample.

### 3/ The number of requests for DNA records removal received by each contributing organisation

We are not able to provide any information on the number of requests for DNA records removal received by each contributing organisation; we process the actual deletion of the record from the NDNAD once the chief constable of the force has made the decision to delete the sample and are not involved in the consideration of each request received by each police force. We therefore do not hold any information on the numbers of DNA removal requests received by each force.

### 4/ The number of DNA profile deleted from the NDNAD for samples taken by each contributing organisation following the granting of a request (under the exceptional case procedure).

The table below shows the number of DNA samples deleted from the NDNAD broken down by Police Force following the approval of an exceptional case removal request for January 2008 – February 27<sup>th</sup> 2009. The reasons for deletion of samples from the NDNAD are recorded manually. Since January 08 the numbers of samples deleted under the exceptional case removal procedure have been collated centrally. To obtain figures prior to January 08 the manual records would need to be interrogated and verified which would exceed the time and cost limits of FOIA requests.

In Scotland the legislation differs from that in England and Wales. In Scotland, DNA profiles obtained from samples taken on arrest may only be retained on the NDNAD if:-

*(1) A conviction is obtained in the case for which the sample was taken.*

(2) For a period of 3 years when a person is arrested for a relevant sexual or violent crime and the case results in a verdict other than guilty, or if no court verdict, providing proceedings are formally commenced and abandoned by the Crown.

Once a case has been completed, or proceedings have been dropped there is the requirement that a Scottish subject sample record also be deleted from the NDNAD but this isn't under the exceptional case removal procedure.

In England and Wales, children aged under 10 cannot be arrested as the legal age of criminal responsibility is 10. Police officers in England and Wales may only take DNA from a child aged under 10 with the consent of a parent or guardian.

A child aged under 10 may have a volunteer DNA sample taken (with parental consent) to eliminate their profile because they were a victim or present at the crime scene. In the recent past, volunteer subject sample profiles taken from children aged under 10 were only added to the NDNAD where the parent or guardian also gave separate written consent for their profile to be loaded and retained on the NDNAD for searching against other unsolved crime scene profiles.

On 16 December 2008, the Home Secretary announced that the Government would take immediate steps to remove the DNA profiles of children aged under 10 from the NDNAD. Following the Home Secretary's announcement, the Chair of the NDNAD Strategy Board and ACPO Lead on DNA, Mr Gary Pugh, wrote to the Chief Constables of all forces in England and Wales asking them to review and remove the profiles of any children aged under 10 on the NDNAD. Since then, all profiles of children aged under 10 have been deleted.

The table below shows the number of samples deleted from the NDNAD taken from children aged under 10, on load to the NDNAD, broken down by police force since 16/12/08. As the Home Secretary's responsibility is England and Wales the figures provided apply to England & Wales forces only.
